PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will construct an improved east-west connection between I-880 and Route 238 (Mission Boulevard) and is a combination of new roadways, improvements to existing roadways and improvements to intersections along Decoto Road, Fremont Boulevard, Paseo Padre Parkway, Alvarado-Niles Road and Route 238 (Mission Boulevard).

PROJECT STATUS

The Alameda CTC leads the project development efforts in cooperation with the cities of Fremont and Union City. A Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) was released for public comment in December 2008. The Alameda County Transportation Authority (ACTA) certified the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) in May 2009 and subsequently approved the project in June 2009. Final design and right-of-way activities (ROW) are currently underway.

The Alameda CTC is working on completing cooperative agreements with local jurisdictions and Interagency coordination is underway with the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG), Army Corps of Engineers (USACOE), BART and Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) in order to obtain the required permits and negotiate and execute the necessary agreements.
