## Certification Standards for Local Business Contract Equity Program

**Business Classifications and Size Thresholds:** 

Local Business Enterprise	Small Local Business	Very Small Local Business
(LBE)	Enterprise (SLBE)	Enterprise (VSLBE)
No Size or Financial Threshold Requirement	Annual revenues averaged over last three (3) years must not exceed US Small Business Administration (SBA) size standard (per primary NAICS code)	\$3.5 million or less annual revenue averaged over last three (3) years

## LBE/SLBE/VSLBE Certification Standards:

In order to become certified, businesses must meet all of the following requirements:

- 1. Hold a valid business license issued by Alameda County or a city within Alameda County for at least six (6) months prior to certification date.
- 2. Be located and fully operational at a fixed place of business within Alameda County where administrative, clerical, professional, and other productive work is continuously performed relative to its commercial contracts for at least six (6) months prior to the certification date, with two types of evidence of maintaining a working office at such business address: (1) proof of a prior or current fully executed contract containing such business address and (2) a lease agreement or proof of ownership of real property for the fixed place of business (a temporary, mobile or virtual office, project work station, telephone answering and/or mail service in an office suite, post office box or address, etc., do not constitute a fixed place of business location).
- 3. Have a minimum of one full-time equivalent employee staffing the Alameda County office, if the business has one or more offices located outside of Alameda County.
- 4. Be bona fide with real and continuing business activities and ownership interests which are not created merely for the purpose of meeting the objectives of the LBCE Program.
- 5. Be economically independent, perform commercially useful functions, and have a customer base (a business acting as a passive conduit rather than contributing a value added or actual portion of the work performed does not qualify for certification).
