BART has encountered a dramatic increase in ridership over the last decade. While weekday ridership has stabilized around 430,000 over the last year, the BART system is heavily burdened by heavier ridership and increased train frequency, accelerating the wear and tear on aging critical assets. BART has embarked on an asset management program and reinvestment bond measure to increase response time and rebuilding critical assets to minimize service delays. During this phase, BART will be rebuilding its system which will require restricted speed areas and shutdown areas to protect its workers and its assets for safety measures. BART has also encountered an increase in passenger-related delays, ranging from medical emergencies, police interventions (crime to welfare checks to homelessness), and unruly customers. BART's senior operational managers are meeting daily to learn from each day's delay to seek operational improvements when necessary.
