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Mobility Programs

- **Hospital Discharge Transportation Service**
 - *Provides accessible rides home or to nursing facilities from participating hospitals (free to riders)*
- **Wheelchair Scooter Breakdown Transportation Service**
 - *Transportation home or to repair facility for stranded individuals*
- **Tri-City Taxi Program**
 - *Accessible same-day service pilot*
- **Paratransit Waiting Areas**
 - *Improvements at high-volume facilities*



Hospital Discharge Transportation Service

- Became a Countywide Program under ACTIA in 2006
- Transportation service that provides rides home or to nursing facilities from participating hospitals (free to riders) within Alameda County
- Rationale
 - Patients may be discharged from a hospital with a health or disability condition that prevents their use of public transit and have no other resources for transportation from the hospital or patients may have a new need for paratransit services
- Hospital Staff gives the patient a voucher to pay for the ride
 - Cost is \$5 per voucher to the Hospital
- 40 rides per month on average this fiscal year

Wheelchair Scooter Breakdown Transportation Service

- Free countywide transportation service to people in mechanical or motorized wheelchairs or scooters in the event of a mechanical breakdown
- One-way ride home or to repair facility for stranded individuals
- Service is also available to pick up a stranded wheelchair if someone is taken to the hospital in an emergency
 - *Service can be requested by consumers or police/fire*
- Transportation within one hour
- 7 rides per month on average this fiscal year

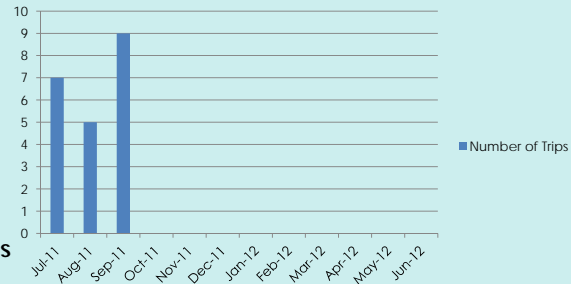

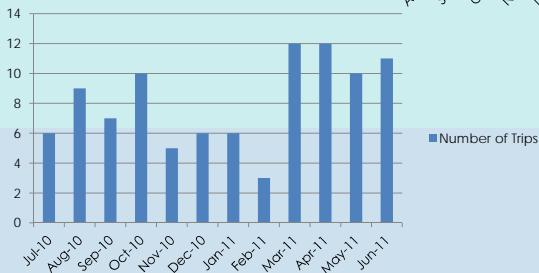


WSBTS Monthly Ridership
