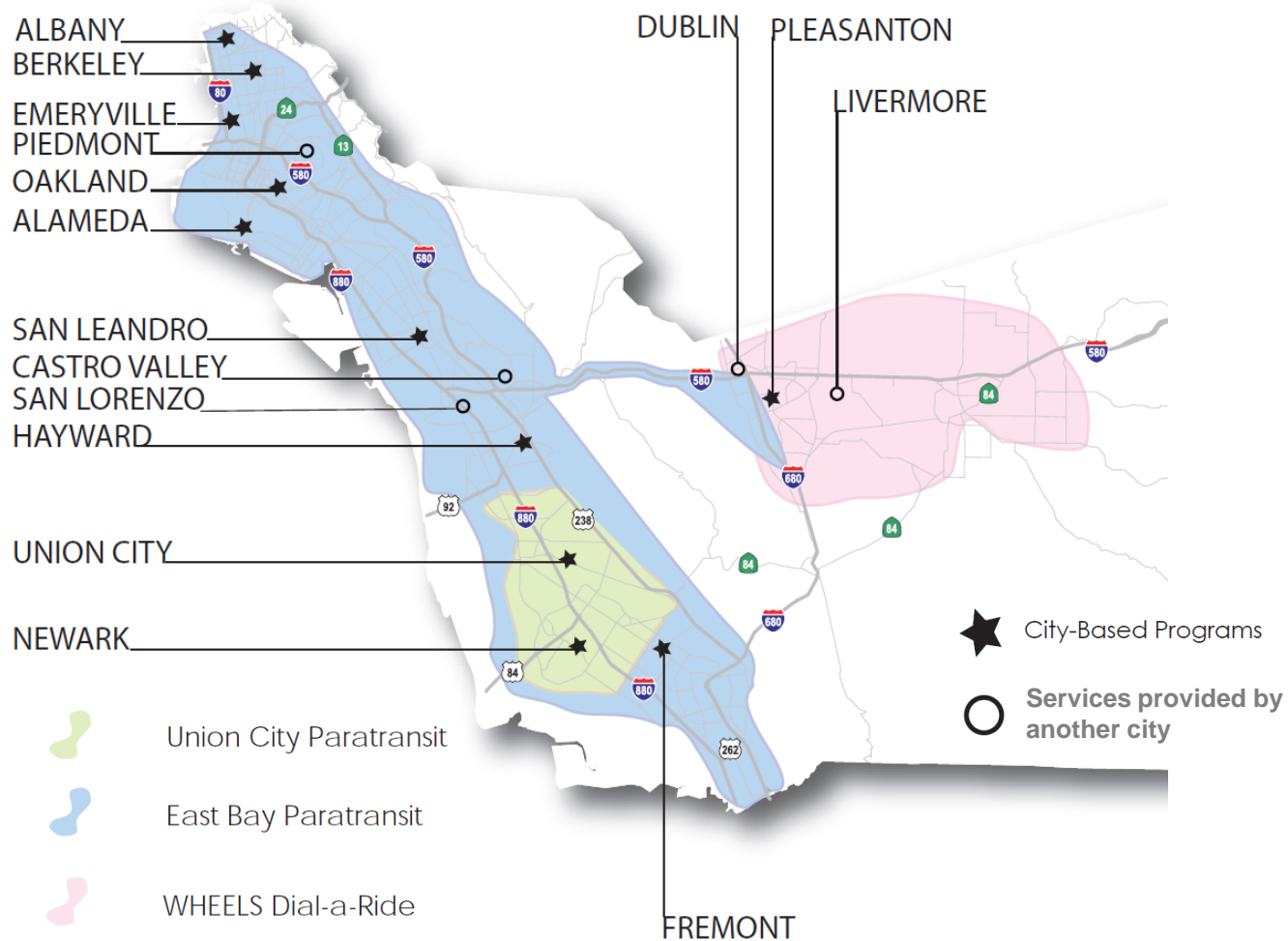

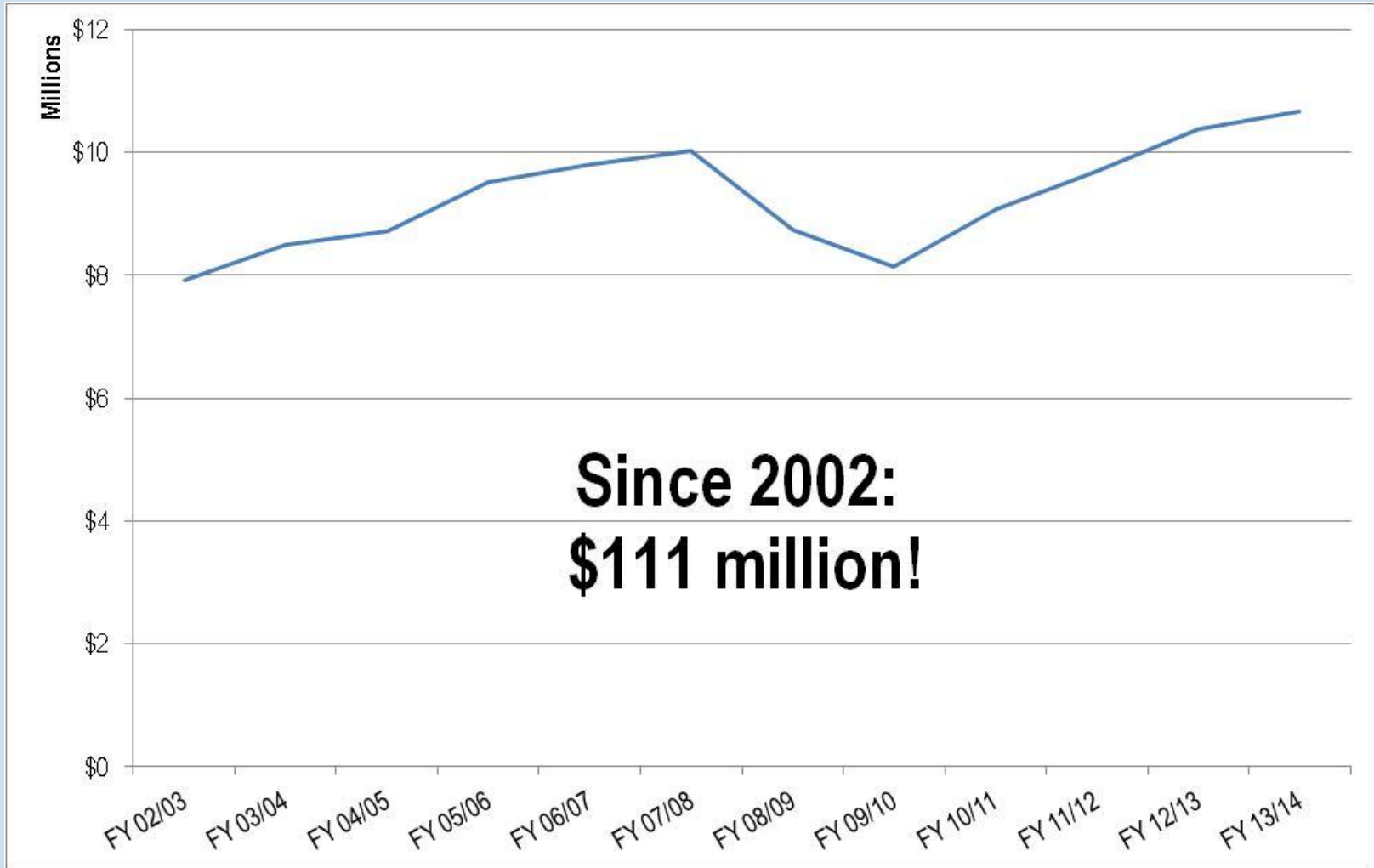
Measure B Specialized Transportation for Seniors and People with Disabilities

- **12 years** of funding for trips in Alameda County (2002 – 2014), will continue through 2022
- 10.45% of Measure B net revenues for Paratransit, approximately **\$9-10 Million per year**
- Largest sales tax-supported paratransit program in the Bay Area
- Funds **25%** of all Alameda County trips for seniors & people with disabilities
- **2014 Measure BB** – would double funding for specialized transportation, BART, and AC Transit

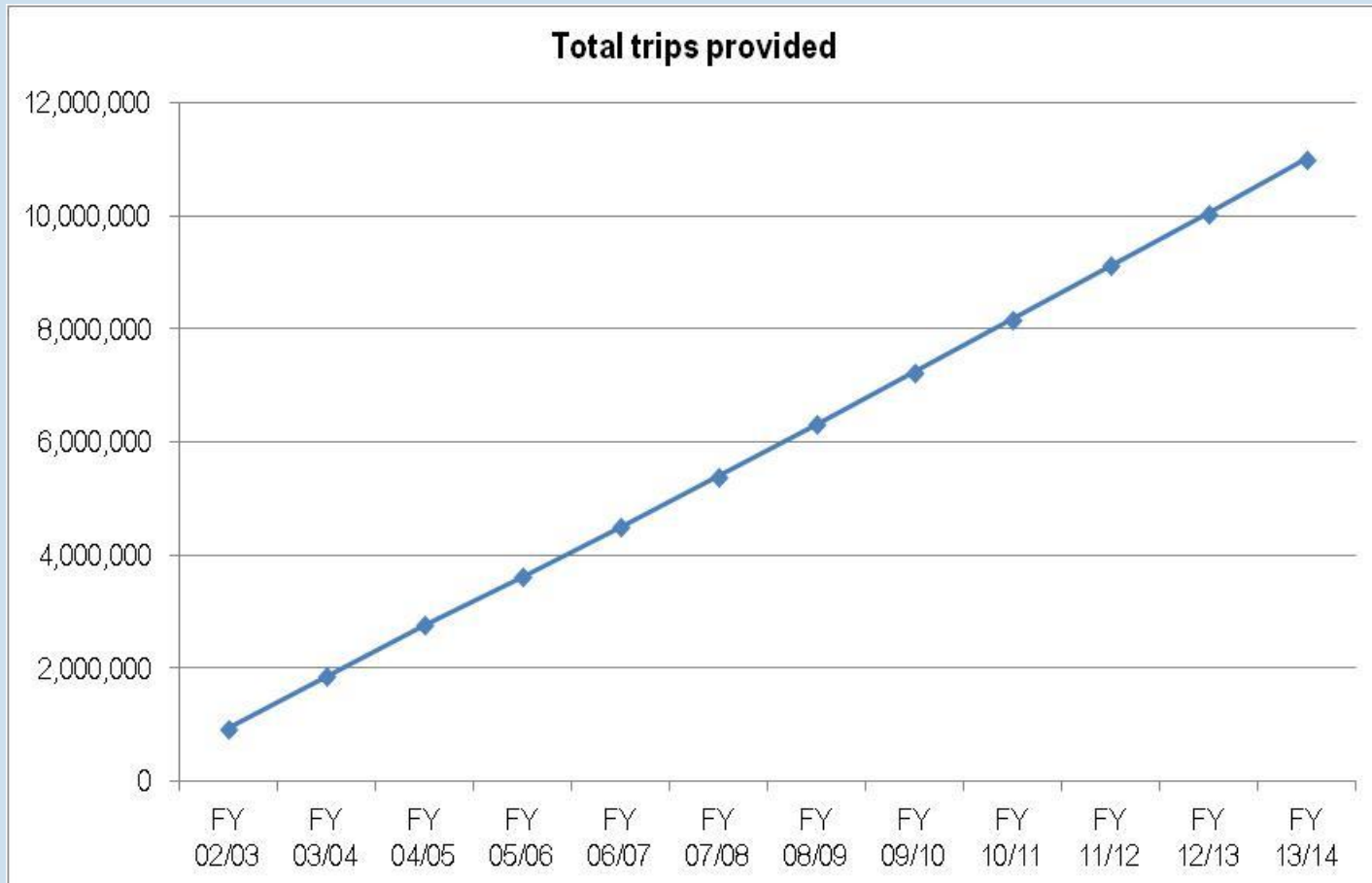

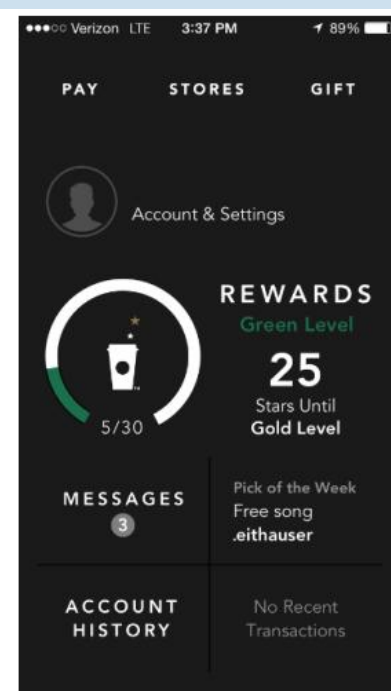
