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Background and Context

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- Three-pronged approach to facilitate development in Priority Development Areas (PDA):
 - **One Bay Area Capital Grants** – investments focused on capital projects in planned PDAs with active development markets; focus was placed on project readiness to meet strict deadline requirements
 - **PDA planning and implementation support** via the Sustainable Communities Technical Assistance Program (SCTAP) – funds planning and technical studies aimed at facilitating PDA growth and development
 - **2014 Transportation Expenditure Plan:** Potential tax revenues for Community Development, Transit, Streets, and Technology and Innovation investments. A complete streets policy is applied to all funds in the measure. Implement planning through construction for PDAs.

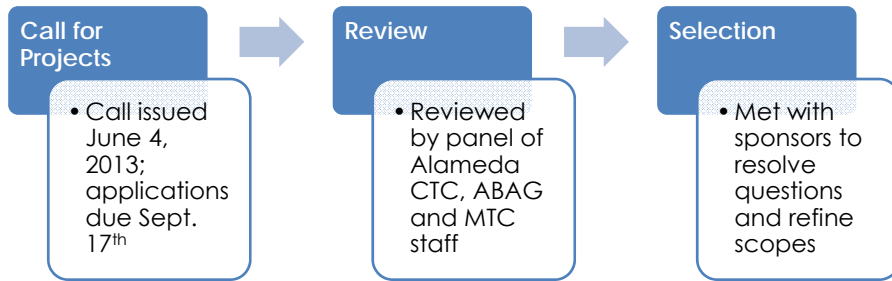
