
- Evaluation framework approved by Commission in March 2016

 - Program cost per participant and administrative costs




















Site Selection – Phase II

- Readiness assessment conducted via phone and email, with input from Alameda County Office of Education (ACOE), Safe Routes to Schools (SR2S), and transit operators
- Assessed on five characteristics:
 - Interest, enthusiasm, and support
 - Leadership continuity
 - Communication mechanisms
 - School culture and programs
 - Summer availability







Model Program Recommendations 4 Pilot programs; 1 in each planning area 11 schools in total All model programs include the following characteristics: Information and training for students on using transit and the applicable passes All passes will be effective year-round, and not be limited by day or time A designated on-site administrator at each school, who will receive training associated with the applicable passs program Leverage: 7 out of the 11 are in Communities of Concern or Disadvantaged Communities
