PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The BART Oakland Airport
Connector (OAC) project
constructed a 3.2 mile Automated
Guideway Transit (AGT) system to
connect the BART Coliseum Station
to the Oakland International
Airport. The AGT alignment runs
mainly in the Hegenberger Rd.
median and along Airport Dr. to the
terminus at the new airport
terminal.

PROJECT STATUS

Work began on the project in November 2010. Construction of the Airport AGT and Coliseum Stations, Maintenance and Storage Facility and the elevated steel truss guideway are complete.

The automated people mover system is designed to reduce the average travel and wait time, increase passenger capacity and provide a more frequent, seamless transit connection between the Coliseum Station and Oakland International Airport. The new "train to plane" service opened to the public on November 22, 2014, in time for the 2014 holiday season.
