### PROJECT SPONSOR

City of Union City

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project involved improving access to and from the Union City BART station in conjunction with the development of the Union City Intermodal Station and surrounding transit oriented development. The project included improving access to the BART station from the west side; reconfiguring the parking facilities; improving the bus facilities at the station and enhancing pedestrian circulation in the station area.

### PROJECT STATUS

Union City obtained environmental clearance for the Redevelopment and General Plans around the station and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) clearance for the rail components of the project. Construction of the 11th Street Extension was completed in November 2005. The construction contract for site improvements was awarded in 2007 and substantially completed in late 2008. A separate contract for the improvements to the BART station was awarded in October 2007 and was substantially completed in late 2011. The contract was accepted in March 2012.

Additional improvements to the Union City BART station area are being coordinated with the Dumbarton Rail Corridor Project and Union City is pursuing funding for the second phase of the project.

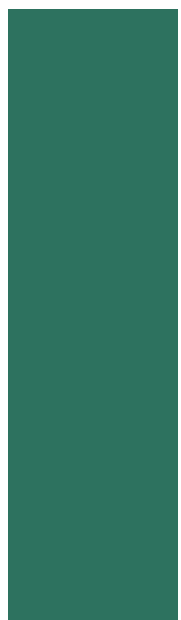
