PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project constructed an auxiliary (AUX) lane on eastbound I-580 between El Charro Road and Airway Boulevard and was included in a larger eastbound project in the Tri-Valley area of Alameda County.

PROJECT STATUS

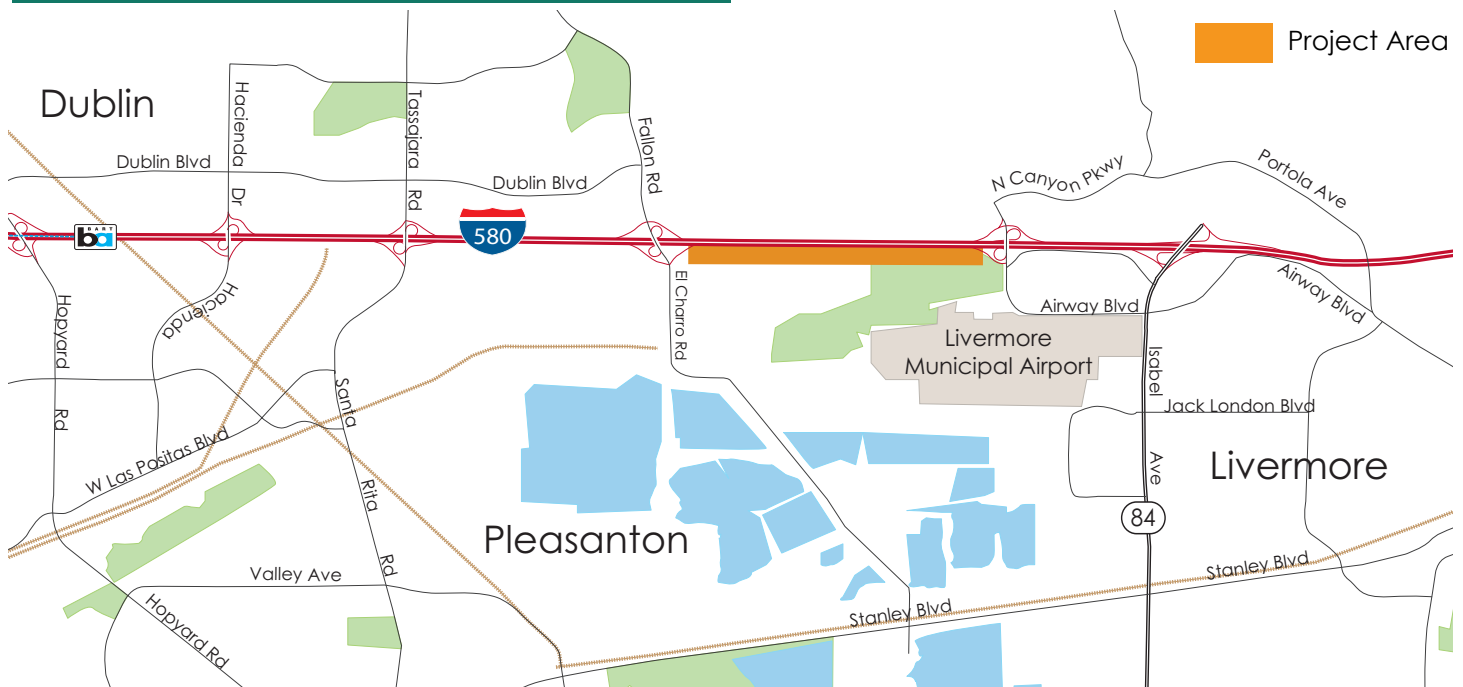
This AUX lane project was part of the Eastbound I-580 High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Lane Project; which was constructed in two segments. Contract #1, the eastern segment, was completed in February 2010. Contract #2, the western segment, included the portion of work between El Charro Road and Airway Boulevard. Contract #2 was awarded in July 2009; work began in August 2009; the HOV lane, between Airway Boulevard and Hacienda Drive was opened in November 2010. Construction is complete; the project was accepted in September 2011.
