From Oakland:

I-980 E signs Walnut Creek/I-980/CA-24 Continue on CA-24 Exit #2 onto Martin Luther King Jr. Way Slight right at Adeline St Left at Martin Luther King Junior Way Right on Allston

From SF:

101 S via the ramp to Oakland/San Jose/US-80 Take the left exit onto I-80 E toward Oakland/Bay Bridge Exit #11 onto University toward Berkeley Turn right on Martin Luther King Jr. Way Turn Left at Allston Way

From the South Bay:

Take I-880 N toward Oakland Slight right on to I-980 E signs Walnut Creek/I-980/CA-24 Continue on CA-24 Exit #2 onto Martin Luther King Jr. Way Slight right at Adeline St Left at Martin Luther King Junior Way Right on Allston

From Walnut Creek:

Take CA-24 W Exit Telegraph Ave and turn right at Telegraph Ave Turn left at Ashby Ave/CA-13 Turn right at Shattuck Ave Turn left at Allston way

Parking:
