#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project plans to identify and acquire right-of-way (ROW) along the I-580 corridor from the Hacienda Drive interchange in Pleasanton to the Vasco Road interchange in Livermore; in order to prevent development from occurring adjacent to the corridor that would preclude an opportunity to widen the freeway corridor in the future. The ROW will include provisions for a mainline High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) and High Occupancy Toll (HOT) lane with a outside buffer, four mixed flow lanes, an auxiliary lane and an inside and outside shoulder in each direction and for a future median transit corridor. Included in the project is the coordination of existing utility relocation to outside of the freeway ROW line.

#### **PROJECT STATUS**

Alameda CTC has signed a cooperative agreement with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) which will provide funding for ROW acquisition. The ROW mapping has been accepted by Caltrans and closeout activities are underway.
