Presentations

- **Alameda CTC Overview:** Alameda CTC plans, funds and delivers over \$100M/year for essential transportation investments.
- **Countywide Transportation Planning Activities:** Planning activities are underway to create a vibrant and livable Alameda County through a connected and integrated multi-modal transportation system that promotes sustainability, access, transit operations, public health and economic opportunities. Over \$10B in investment strategies are underway.
- **Senior Support Programs of the Tri-Valley:** Measure B grants provide funding for innovative senior support programs assisting seniors in the Tri-Valley area with transportation services that foster independence, promote safety and well being, preserve dignity and improve quality of life.
- **WHEELS Transit Advancements:** Tri-Valley Rapid Transit System offers environmentally friendly technology with faster travel, fewer stops and a frequent schedule. WHEELS public transit also offers a range of accessible options for seniors and people with disabilities, such as travel training, Dial-a-Ride, paratransit services and senior housing shuttles.
- **I-580 Corridor Update:** Projects include congestion relief and mobility enhancements in the I-580 Corridor, including construction of High Occupancy Toll (HOT) Lanes. Work entails Eastbound HOT Lane and Westbound HOT Lane improvements.
- **Route 84 Expressway Update:** Project involves widening a 4.6 mile section of Isabel Avenue, from Ruby Hill Drive to Jack London Boulevard, expanding from two lanes to four lanes and to six lanes.
