First Year In Review February 2016 - February 2017

OVERALL RESULTS:

Commuters are benefiting: less congestion, greater reliability and expanded choices in the I-580 Express Lanes through the Tri-Valley.



Smart

- More than 7.6 million trips have been made in the I-580 Express Lanes since they opened.
- Approximately 30,000 trips are taken in the Express Lanes each day.
- Approximately 11% of all traffic in the corridor utilizes the Express Lanes.



Reliable

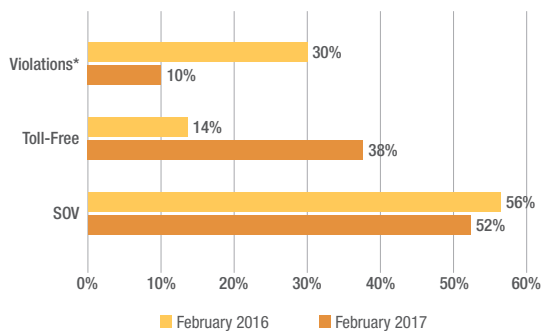
- The speed to travel the entire corridor averaged 10 mph faster in the Express Lanes than the general purpose lanes.
- I-580 Express Lane commuters enjoy less congestion, making driving more comfortable and reliable.
- Express Lane infrastructure and toll-free use are enticing more commuters to switch to carpooling.



Choice

- Everyone benefits from the Express Lane choice.
- 6% of the corridor's solo drivers choose to use the Express Lanes as toll-paying customers instead of the general purpose lanes, reducing congestion in the general purpose lanes.
- 38 percent of current Express Lane users are using the lanes toll-free.

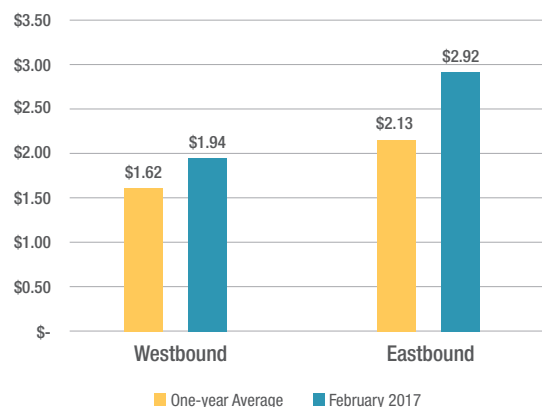
Average Daily Trip Breakdown



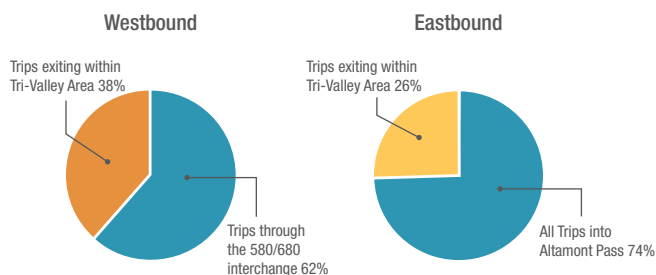

Average Assessed Toll

- Westbound: Average toll charged for all trips \$1.62
- Eastbound: Average toll charged for all trips \$2.13



How are the Express Lanes Used?



Minimum and Maximum Tolls

- Minimum toll \$0.50 to travel one zone.
- Maximum possible westbound toll is capped at \$13.00.
 - Highest actual toll to date of \$9.75 from end to end westbound, reached on 1 day.
- Maximum eastbound toll is capped at \$9.00.
 - Highest actual toll of \$9.00 to date from end to end eastbound, reached on 12 days.

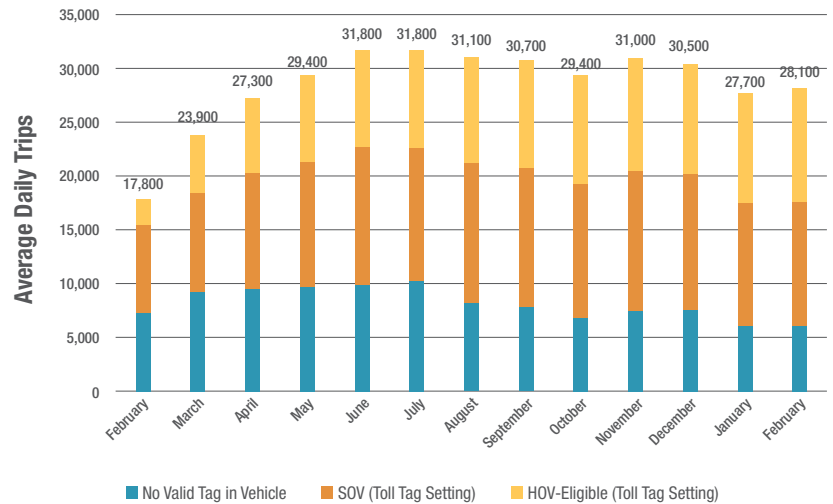

580 Express Lanes Facts

- Carpools always use the Express Lanes toll free with a FasTrak® Flex toll tag set in the 2 or 3+ position.
- There are 15 toll readers eastbound and 16 in the westbound direction.
- There are a total of 29.1 lane-miles on the 580 Express Lanes.
 - 1 westbound lane
 - 2 eastbound lanes
- Friday, November 18, 2016 was the busiest day since opening, with 42,551 trips.
- Electronic violation enforcement system ensures virtually nobody gets away with cheating.

February 2016 - February 2017



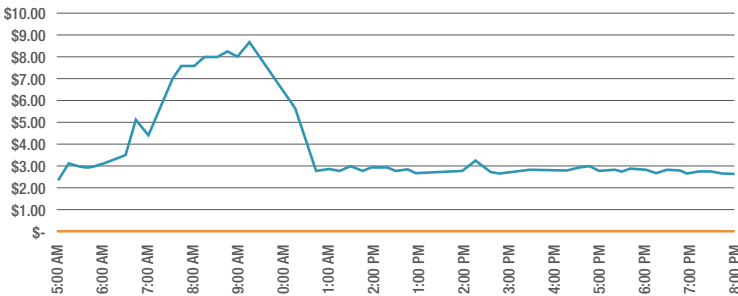
Congestion-Based Pricing

- Tolls are the primary tool used to keep traffic moving smoothly and to maintain reliable speeds on the Express Lanes. Tolls vary by the amount of congestion in the corridor.

Typical Day Express Lane Pricing
