### **Public Comments**

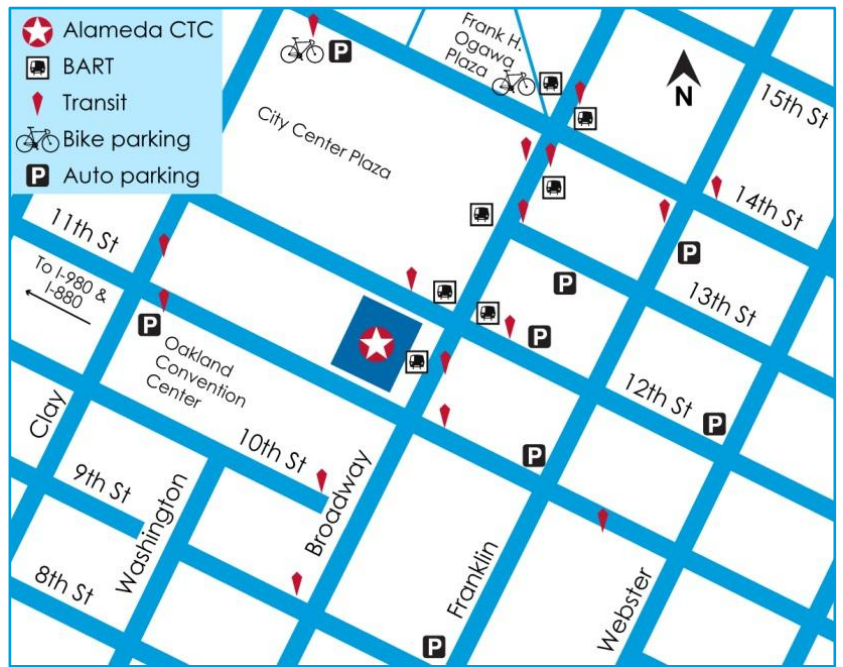
