LEVINE ACT STATEMENT

PRIME CONSULTANT AND SUBCONSULTANTS/SUBCONTRACTORS MUST COMPLETE, SIGN AND SUBMIT THIS STATEMENT

California Government Code § 84308, commonly referred to as the "Levine Act," precludes an officer of a local government agency from participating in the award of a contract (including award of a contract amendment) if he or she receives any political contributions totaling more than \$250 in the 12 months preceding the pendency of the contract award, and for three months following the final decision, from the person or company awarded the contract. This prohibition applies to contributions to the officer, or received by the officer on behalf of any other officer, or on behalf of any candidate for office or on behalf of any committee.
