








PLUS: "Pill Hill", Berkeley Bowl, MacArthur BART, and more


TRANSPORTATION FOR SENIORS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES IN THE 9440B AREA

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The "8-To-Go" Benefits to the Public...




- Improved quality of life in transportation "gap" area of County (West Oakland and Emeryville Transportation Studies)
- Less expensive than EBP...and better service than taxis
- Wheelchair accessible (unlike most taxis)



Why Measure B Funding was Needed...



- Provided initial seed money for purchasing shuttle
- Provides shuttle operational funding for "free" service
- Allowed for partnership to flourish b/w Emery-Go-Round and City of Emeryville



Current Status and Future of "8-To-Go"...



Future:

- Nominal rider fees?
- Volunteer operated?
- Part-time service?
- Multiple funding streams to continue full-time service?

Currently:

- 2 years & 9 months of service (and counting)
- ~15 rides/day to senior centers, medical, grocery, family, banks, restaurants, etc are provided
- ~350 registered riders
- ~\$15 per trip
- Measure B "Gap Grant" funding through 6/30/2012
