Please note that October has a PAPCO meeting followed by a PAPCO/TAC Joint meeting. We will be meeting from 1 to 4 p.m. Please plan your transportation accordingly. The agenda packet is enclosed.

Also, please note that the City of Oakland is doing construction at the North corner of 12th and Broadway, in front of the Wells Fargo. All pavement and sidewalks are blocked and there are temporary walkways partitioned off in the street. This construction is due to a serious safety issue and will be continuing into December. If you use the BART street elevator located on Broadway between 11th and 12th, it is strongly recommended that you use the BART street elevator at the opposite end of the station, at 14th and Broadway, instead. Alternatively, you may also travel about 250 feet West on 12th towards Clay, where there is a safer crosswalk and you can traverse through City Center to our building.
