
# Attention!!!

Please note that October has a PAPCO meeting followed by a PAPCO/TAC Joint meeting. We will be meeting from 1 to 4 p.m. Please plan your transportation accordingly. The agenda packet is enclosed.

Also, please note that the City of Oakland is doing construction at the North corner of 12<sup>th</sup> and Broadway, in front of the Wells Fargo. All pavement and sidewalks are blocked and there are temporary walkways partitioned off in the street. This construction is due to a serious safety issue and will be continuing into December. If you use the BART street elevator located on Broadway between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, it is strongly recommended that you use the BART street elevator at the opposite end of the station, at 14<sup>th</sup> and Broadway, instead. Alternatively, you may also travel about 250 feet West on 12<sup>th</sup> towards Clay, where there is a safer crosswalk and you can traverse through City Center to our building.
