Please turn off your cell phones during the meeting. Please do not wear scented products so individuals with environmental sensitivities may attend the meeting.




Recording of Public Meetings

The executive director or designee may designate one or more locations from which members of the public may broadcast, photograph, video record, or tape record open and public meetings without causing a distraction. If the Commission or any committee reasonably finds that noise, illumination, or obstruction of view related to these activities would persistently disrupt the proceedings, these activities must be discontinued or restricted as determined by the Commission or such committee (CA Government Code Sections 54953.5-54953.6).

Alameda CTC is accessible by multiple transportation modes. The office is conveniently located near the 12th Street/City Center BART station and many AC Transit bus lines. Bicycle parking is available on the street and in the BART station as well as in electronic lockers at 14th Street and Broadway near Frank Ogawa Plaza (requires purchase of key card from bikelink.org).



Garage parking is located beneath City Center, accessible via entrances on 14th Street between 1300 Clay Street and 505 14th Street buildings, or via 11th Street just past Clay Street. To plan your trip to Alameda CTC visit www.511.org.

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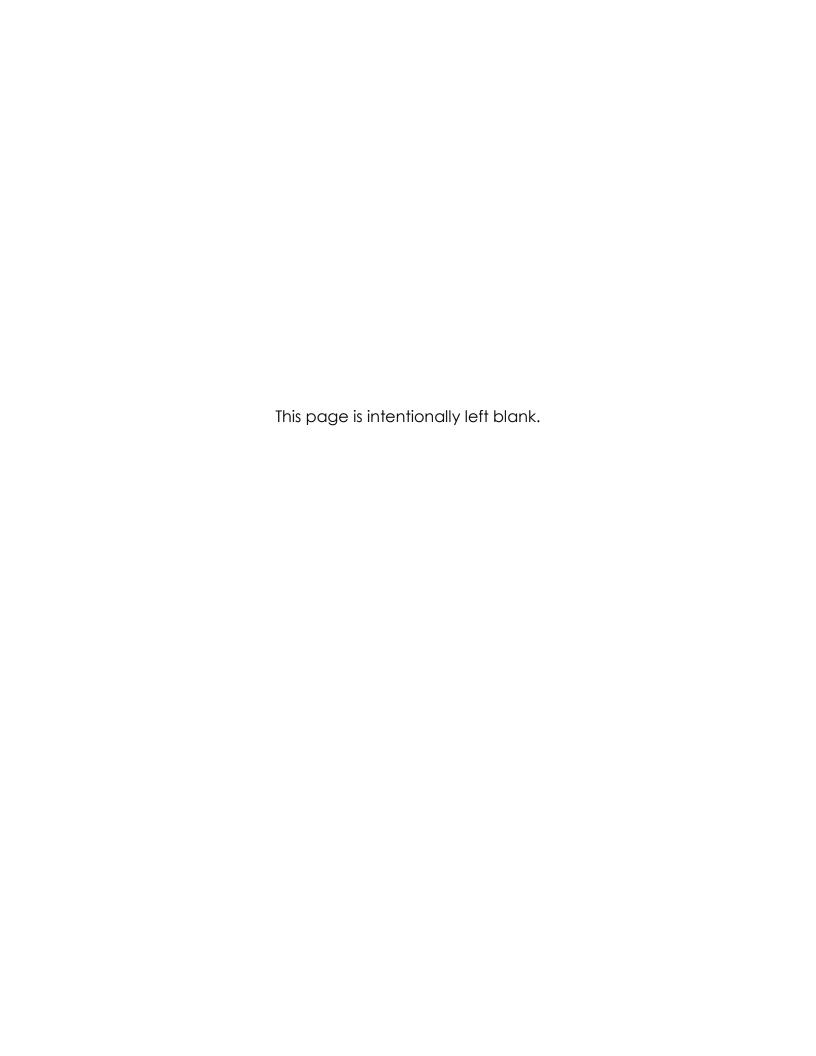

MEETING MINUTES

1. Welcome and Introductions

Naomi Armenta called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m. The meeting began with introductions and a review of the meeting outcomes.

2. Public Comment

There was no public comment.

3. Review Prior Meeting Minutes

ParaTAC members reviewed the meeting minutes from January 14, 2014 and by consensus approved them as written.

4. Direct Local Program Distribution Estimates Update

Naomi Armenta and John Hemiup gave an update on the direct local program distribution estimates. John noted that staff will not be producing a mid-year funding update, however, actual tax revenue information will be posted each month and the projections will be updated accordingly.

5. Access Alameda Revision Update

Naomi Armenta and Cathleen Sullivan gave an update on the Access Alameda guide and website revision process. She noted that staff will be asking for additional information from ADA mandated and city based programs regarding their individual pages as well as contact information and a high resolution photo.

Questions and feedback from ParaTAC members:

- Will there be a photo release form available? Yes, staff will email ParaTAC members the photo release form after the meeting.
- When are the high resolution photos due? They will be due in the next few weeks.
- Have we received any feedback from individuals who actually distribute the Access Alameda guide at outreach events? Yes, Krystle is involved in the revision process and she distributes the guides regularly at outreach events.
- How many guides do you distribute in one fiscal year? We distribute about 3,000 guides each fiscal year. The Access Alameda guide is the most popular piece of information that the agency distributes.
- Will the application still be available in the Access Alameda guide? Yes, the city based paratransit program application will still be available in the Access Alameda guide.
- What languages will these guides be available in? Staff is planning to print the guides in English, Spanish, Chinese, Tagalog, Vietnamese, Farsi as well as Braille.

6. Program Plan Application Completion Workshop

Naomi and Cathleen facilitated a program plan application completion workshop for Committee members.

Questions and feedback from ParaTAC members:

- Our cost per trip looks really high but in actuality the Excel form is counting our Measure B, fare revenues and City general funds more than once. In response, staff agreed to correct and resend the forms.
- This application and the forms would be very helpful if they were available as an online form or tool on the web.

7. 2014 Annual Mobility Workshop Brainstorm

Cathleen Sullivan and John Hemiup gave an update on the 2014 Annual Mobility Workshop. John noted that staff is proposing to host the Workshop at the Alameda CTC offices as well as decreasing the amount of time for the overall Workshop and altering the agenda accordingly. Cathleen then facilitated a brainstorm for Workshop ideas and themes.

Questions and feedback from ParaTAC members:

- I agree with both of the proposed changes.
- I like the full day Workshop because it allows for longer break times which lets us talk to other people from other areas.
- I like the Ed Roberts Campus because it is really accessible whereas Paratransit is having some difficulty dropping off individuals at the Alameda CTC offices. I also like the length of the Workshop as is.
- Members suggested possible presentation topics including an update on the San Francisco paratransit parking policy, the electronic debit card system for taxi

programs, an update on the state of the system (including new areas of development in Alameda County), and accessible taxis.

8. Technical Exchange

8.1. Mobility Management

Naomi Armenta noted that the Regional Mobility Management Working Group has been pretty active and is hosting a meeting on issues around accessible taxis. ParaTAC members are welcome to join that meeting at the Ed Roberts Campus. She also noted that staff is making progress on the 211 inventory and website.

John Hemiup gave an update on the Gap Grant matching and capital funds requests. Staff notified the applicants that they received full funding for their requests.

8.2. Preparedness

Laura Timothy gave an update on East Bay Paratransit's emergency preparedness plan development. Staff is currently conducting interviews.

8.3. Ask a ParaTAC Member

The City of Emeryville paratransit program successfully transitioned their 8-to-Go program in which they are now charging \$1.00 for every ride. They are doing well and are hitting their target for expected revenue shares. They are also still considering switching over to the annual membership fee model for next fiscal year.

8.4. Other Technical Exchange Items

There were no other technical exchange items discussed.

9. Information Items

9.1. SRAC Update

The next SRAC meeting is on Tuesday, March 4th. East Bay Paratransit will be showcasing their new vehicles at this meeting.

9.2. PAPCO Update and Appointments

Sylvia Stadmire gave a PAPCO update and noted that the next PAPCO and Joint PAPCO and ParaTAC meeting is on Monday, February 24th. She also noted that there are three PAPCO vacancies; one for Supervisor Valle and the others for the Cities of Piedmont and Newark.

9.3. Alameda CTC Staff Report

John Hemiup gave a staff update on the RFPs for the paratransit contract as well as the HDTS and WSBTS programs contract.

9.4. Outreach Update

Krystle Pasco gave an update on PAPCO's outreach activities. She noted that staff is looking forward to the next outreach, the Developmental Disabilities Council's Transition Information Faire, on Saturday, March 15, 2014 at the College of Alameda.

9.5. ParaTAC Member Announcements

Kadri Külm announced that LAVTA just completed their RFP process for a new paratransit operations and maintenance contractor. The board awarded the contract to Medical Transportation Management (MTM) and they will begin service on May 1st.

Kim Ridgeway announced that seniors can now get their Senior Clipper cards through the mail but staff has also been requested to distribute Senior Clipper cards at outreach events. If ParaTAC members have any events where they would like to have Senior Clipper cards distributed, please contact Kim at AC Transit.
