The City Council passes a budget every two years based upon projected income. Based on recent experience, the Council has budgeted \$400,000 VRF per year for the next two years, assuming \$300,000 will accrue, and the fund balance will be eventually drawn down. The intent each year is to go out to bid in the early spring, then use the funds to pay off the construction contract in the fall of the following FY. This always results in some funds carrying over to the next FY. If there is more in the fund than expected, Public Works can request that the City Council authorize use of additional VRF funds, at the time the contract is awarded.
