The Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC), in partnership with the City of Oakland and the Port of Oakland, proposes to implement the Global Opportunities at the Port of Oakland (GoPort) Program, a package of landside transportation improvements within and near the Port of Oakland.

The Freight Intelligent Transportation System (FITS) projects, the first set of GoPort Program projects are demonstration information technology projects to be implemented along West Grand Avenue, Maritime Street, 7th Street, Middle Harbor Road, Adeline Street and Embarcadero West, that are intended to improve truck traffic flows, increase the efficiency of goods movement operations, and enhance the safety and incident response capabilities throughout the seaport.
