

Project Overview

- Close the gap in the Alameda County I-680 Express Lanes network
- 10 mile segment from Contra Costa County line to SR-84
- Project consists of:
 - Roadway Widening (Addition of HOV/EL lanes, retaining walls, sound walls)
 - Median Barrier Reconstruction
 - Toll Signage and Equipment
 - No Right-of-Way Acquisition
 - Two Phases
 - Southbound Phase 1
 - Northbound Phase 2

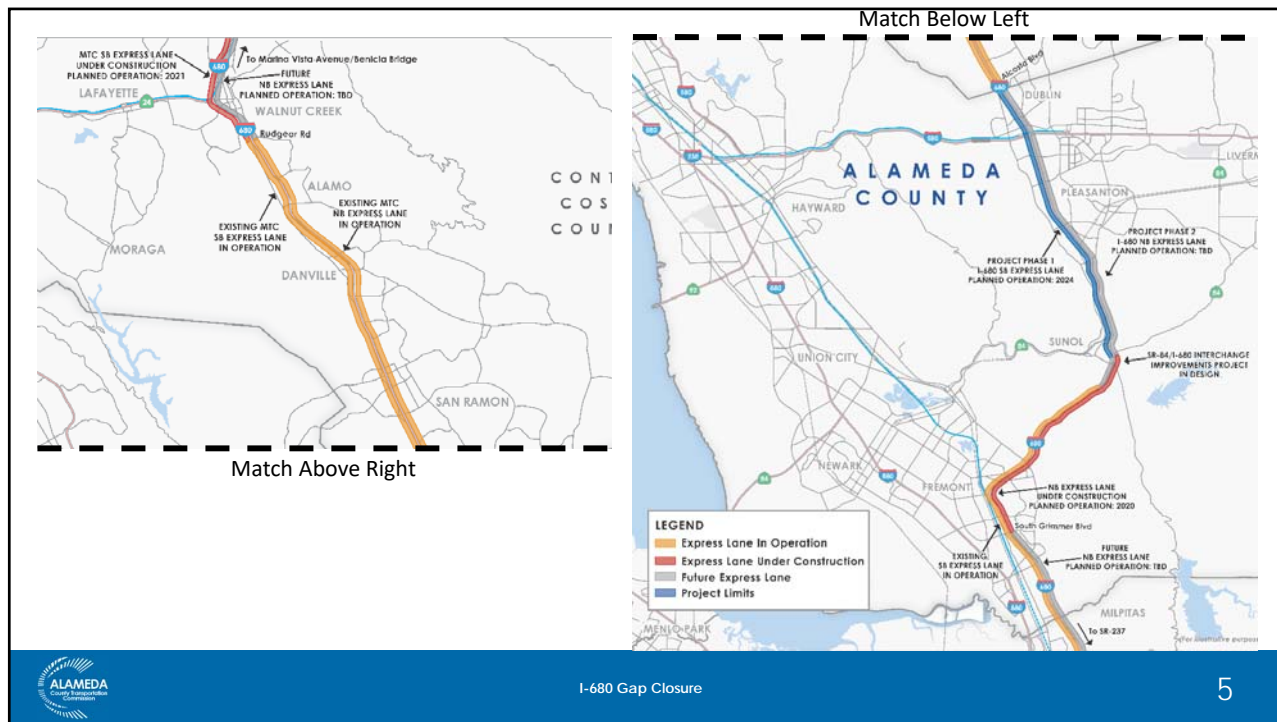
Project Schedule

Phase 1 I-680 SB Express Lane from SR-84 to Alcosta Boulevard

Season/Year	Milestone
Fall 2019	Begin Final Design and Right-of-Way
Winter 2020	DED circulation
Summer 2020	Env Document Complete
Fall 2021	Finish Final Design and Right-of-Way RTL
Spring 2022	Begin Construction
Fall 2024	Finish Construction

Phase 2 – Northbound Express Lane Schedule is TBD





Project Cost Estimate

Phase 1 I-680 SB Express Lane from SR-84 to Alcosta Boulevard

Phase	Cost (in millions)
Planning/Scoping	\$1*
Environmental	\$6.5*
Final Design (PS&E)	\$22.5
Right-of-Way	\$7
Construction Capital	\$245
Total	\$282

*includes costs for Phase 2 – Northbound Express Lane
