## Paratransit Technical Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, January 14, 2020, 9:30 a.m.

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#### 1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Krystle Pasco called the meeting to order and a roll call was conducted. All members were present with the exception of Steve Adams, Tanya Bustamante, Shawn Fong, and Brad Helfenberger.

## Subsequent to the roll call:

Shawn Fong arrived during item 4.1, and Kadri Kulm arrived during item 4.2.

#### 2. Public Comment

There were no public comments.

#### 3. Administration

## 3.1. Review the March 12, 2019 ParaTAC Meeting Minutes

Committee members received the March 12, 2019 ParaTAC meeting minutes and agreed by acclamation.

## 3.2. Review the FY 2019-20 ParaTAC Meeting Calendar

The FY 2019-20 ParaTAC meeting calendar was provided in the agenda packet for review purposes.

#### 3.3. PAPCO Roster

The PAPCO roster was provided in the agenda packet for review purposes.

#### 3.4. Paratransit Outreach Calendar

The paratransit outreach calendar was provided in the agenda packet for review purposes.

## 4. Paratransit Programs and Projects

## 4.1. Paratransit Direct Local Distribution (DLD) Projections

Krystle Pasco reviewed this agenda item. She reiterated that Measure B and Measure BB paratransit Direct Local Distribution (DLD) funding is split by planning area and within each planning area by a formula adopted by PAPCO. Ms. Pasco reviewed the funding distributions as stated in both the 2000 and 2014 Transportation Expenditure Plans (TEPs). She reviewed the percentage of funds allocated to ADA-mandated paratransit services/East Bay Paratransit, City-based programs, and the discretionary grant program as stated in the TEPs.

Laura Timothy asked when will the participants stop receiving funds for Measure B. Naomi Armenta stated that Measure B revenues will be collected through March 2022.

This item is for information only.

## 4.2. City/Program Approaches to TNCs Discussion (Verbal)

Naomi Armenta facilitated the discussion around the planned use of Transportation Network Companies (TNCs).

Jessica Lobedan stated that Hayward recently expanded their service areas using TNCs through LIFE ElderCare. The City of Hayward will transition from LIFE ElderCare to Eden I&R as the call center and arranging and monitoring the rides.

Hakeim McGee asked about the capacity of Eden I&R. Ms. Armenta suggested bringing Eden I&R to a future ParaTAC meeting to provide more information about their services.

Hakeim McGee asked what is going on with LIFE ElderCare's human services. Andrea Mok stated that LIFE ElderCare's strength is door-through-door services and they plan to expand this program into North County.

Hakeim McGee asked if the City of Hayward has accessible wheelchair service. Andrea Mok said she made a connection with UberWAV and inquired about the availability of on-demand vehicles that are accessible. She noted that UberWAV is releasing accessible vans from Pleasanton to Palo Alto using MV Transportation. The longest wait time is approximately 25-30 minutes.

Hakeim McGee asked for clarification on the relationship between the City of Hayward and Eden I&R in regards to insurance. Jessica Lobedan said she'll get back to the Committee with more information.

Shawn Fong gave an update on the City of Fremont's TNC program. Their service started with LIFE ElderCare for individuals that need to call into a call center for rides and the City of Fremont service started with Lyft on November 15, 2019. Ms. Fong noted that Fremont enrolls the client and the person pays the first \$4 for the ride and the client is responsible for any amount over \$20.

Hakeim McGee asked about the technology. Ms. Fong said that the most difficult piece is getting the client to download the Lyft mobile app and setup their payment source; however, once that is done, the mobile app is very easy to use.

Hakeim McGee asked if the contractual information for Uber and Lyft can be provided to the Committee. He also suggested this topic become a recurring agenda item.

Naomi Armenta encouraged the Committee members to reach out to each other to continue communications and coordination around this topic and any other concerns.

## 4.3. FY 2020-21 Program Plan Application Update

Naomi Armenta presented this item. She reviewed FY 2020-21 Paratransit Program Plan application form and tables, which included minor changes. Ms. Armenta informed the Committee that the Program Plan Review Subcommittees were scheduled for April 27 and 28, 2020.

This item is for information only.

## 4.4. Mobility Management Update (Verbal)

Marvin Ranaldson provided an update on the upcoming February 24, 2020 Joint PAPCO and ParaTAC meeting. He noted that the focus is the state of emerging mobility in Alameda County with particular focus on TNCs for people with disabilities. The speakers will be Naomi Armenta, with Nelson\Nygaard Consulting Associates; Marilyn Golden with the Disability Rights Education and Defense Fund (DREDF); Tim McCormick with Santa Monica Big Blue Bus; and Jonathan Steketee with Livermore Amador Valley Transit Authority (LAVTA).

## 4.5. Emergency Preparedness Update

Naomi Armenta provided an update on the Bay Area Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Paratransit Critical Transportation Project. She noted that in 2019 the Bay Area UASI worked with the Bay Area Partnership Accessibility Committee (BAPAC) on a paratransit critical transportation project, which focused on ADA-paratransit. She noted that a list of meetings and workshops that have taken place and several products and services are being prepared through this process.

Laura Timothy stated that if we reach out to UASI staff they may come to ParaTAC or any agency that is interested with information.

## 4.6. Exchange Technical Information

Laura Timothy stated her concerns regarding East Bay Paratransit receiving additional work since the Regional Center of the East Bay is scaling back. She noted that the current provider may be backing out of their contract with the Regional Center of the East Bay.

Jessica Lobedan asked if anyone is working with providers that are working with Getaround and if anyone else is partnering with them and are having problems with insurance. Ms. Armenta said she doesn't know of anyone in the Bay Area partnering with them; however, she will check with her networks.

Mary Triston asked about alternative transportation for medical appointments. She wanted clarification on medical trips. Shawn Fong said that state legislation says that all medical providers should provide transportation. Ms. Fong encouraged Committee members to contact her for additional information.

## 5. Committee and Transit Reports

## 5.1. PAPCO Update

Krystle Pasco informed the Committee that PAPCO last met on November 18, 2019 and the next meeting is taking place on March 23, 2020. She noted that PAPCO will be discussing the Program Plan Review process.

## 5.2. ADA and Transit Advisory Committee Updates (Verbal)

There were no ADA and Transit Advisory Committee updates.

## 6. Member Reports

Mary Triston announced that their program's name is changing to Berkeley Rides for Seniors and the Disabled (BRSD).

## 7. Staff Reports

Naomi Armenta gave an update on the FTA Section 5310 grant call for projects.

Ms. Armenta also gave an update on the City-based program application. She stated that the webform does not request gender; however, the paper application does. She reviewed both forms and found some differences. Ms. Armenta asked the Committee if they wanted staff to update the gender to be more relevant to today's world.

Krystle Pasco gave an update on Senate Bill 1376, the TNC Access for All Act.
