Demographics

•Berkeley residents:

- •15.1% are seniors (65+)
- 8.6% are people with disabilities
- 26% of seniors have a disability
- 15% of seniors have a household income less than 150% of the poverty level

Program Benefits

Berkeley Rides for Seniors & the Disabled (BRSD) currently assists 1,114 Berkeley residents with disabilities and those 70 years of age + (age limit lowered effective April 1, 2021) by providing the following supplemental transportation programs:

- Taxi Scrip Program
 - Provides \$720 of free taxi scrip per year
- Wheelchair Van Program
 - Provides 36 free van vouchers per year
- High Medical Need Program
 - Provides \$1,440 of free taxi scrip per year
 - Provides 48 free van vouchers per year

Program Benefits (Continued)

East Bay Paratransit Tickets

Provides 9 to 18 \$4 tickets per year.

Travel Training

Prior to COVID-19, in collaboration with United Seniors of Oakland and Alameda County, BRSD has hosted 3 trainings per year on how to effectively and safely use public transportation.

Highlights From FY 2020

Total number of 1 way trips: 13,742:

- Total number of taxi cab trips: 12,916
- Total number of wheelchair accessible trips: 826

COVID 19 Challenges

Decrease in number of rides: In comparison to the previous year, there has been an approximate 45% decrease in the number of taxi rides and 36% decrease in the number of accessible wheelchair van rides:

April 2019 – December 2019	April 2020 – December 2020
Taxi Rides: 12,550	Taxi Rides: 6,863
Wheelchair Van Rides: 641	Wheelchair Van Rides: 408

 GoGoGrandparent (GGG) Pilot Delayed: The launch of the pilot was delayed until September 2020.

COVID 19 & Other Challenges (continued)

- Community Outreach: We did not conduct any in person community outreach to our local service providers and community
- Travel Trainings: We are not able to host any travel trainings due to the closure of our senior centers.
- Consistent Decrease in City Taxi Cabs and Drivers: We continue to see a consistent and significant decrease in taxi cabs and drivers.

FY 21-22 Program Plan Highlights

GoGoGrandparent (GGG) Program

 Beginning April 1, 2021, BRSD added GGG has an additional transportation service to 180 program participants.

Some GGG Pilot Program Survey highlights:

- 48% responded very satisfied with GGG service
- 23% responded satisfied with GGG service
- 78% responded ride came within 15 minutes
- 72% responded my call was answered in a timely manner
- 74% responded GGG call center was helpful and supportive

FY 21-22 Program Plan Highlights (continued)

BRSD Age Eligibility Requirement

 Beginning April 1, 2021, BRSD revised its age eligibility requirement for City of Berkeley residents from 80 years + to 70 years and older.
