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# **Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Implementation** FHWA issued highway, bridge, and electric charging infrastructure formula apportionments FTA issued partial-year transit formula apportionments DOT released first discretionary funding opportunities ٠ 180-day milestone for agency implementation by May 13, 2022

# NEVI Formula Program \$5 billion program to support EV charging deployment along Alternative Fuel Corridors \$56,789,406 for California in FY 2022 Eligible Activities: acquisition, installation, and upgrades; operations and maintenance (O&M); traffic control devices; on-premises signs; development phase activities; community outreach and participation; data sharing; mapping and analysis Equity considerations required during planning and implementation Nominations for Alternative Fuel Corridors due <u>May 13, 2022</u> and state EV plans due <u>August 1, 2022</u>

# FY 2022 Appropriations

- Further Extending Government Funding Act (P.L 117-70) set to expire on February 18, 2022
- House of Representatives passed another short-term Continuing Resolution (H.R. 6617) through <u>March</u> <u>11, 2022</u>
- We are awaiting Senate consideration of that measure
- Appropriators seeking agreement on omnibus before <u>March 11, 2022</u> deadline
- Fate of Commission's \$1.7 million Community Project Funding request for Safe Routes to Schools Mini-Grant Program sponsored by Congressman Swalwell will be determined by omnibus

# **Build Back Better**

- Senator Manchin announced opposition to House-passed version of Build Back Better Act (H.R. 5376)
- Legislation included:
  - \$550 billion, largest national investment to date, to address climate and enhance resiliency
  - \$10 billion for HUD-FTA Affordable Housing Access Program
  - \$10 billion for FRA Passenger Rail Improvement, Modernization, and Emissions Reduction Grants
  - Tax credits for new, used, and commercial electric vehicles
- · Senator Lujan out for health issues consideration delayed until his return
- · Prospects remain increasingly uncertain as to fate of package in Senate
