Housekeeping Rules



 The project consists of construction of a realignment of 7th Street and a new undercrossing of the UPRR railroad between I-880 and Maritime Street in Oakland. Project working days are 755 Working Days.

Tiebacks Pump Station

Site Dewatering Drainage

Concrete Retaining Walls Railroad Trackwork and Flagging

Piling Steel Bridge Construction

Demolition Signing and Striping







Project Overview: Stage 1, Phase 1












Project Overview: Stage 1, Phase 2






Project Overview: Stage 2, Phases 1 and 2







 - Public Information
- Requirements are included in the Special Provisions and Informational Handout



Project Overview: Water Pollution Control

- Risk Level 2
- Substantial dewatering and treatment anticipated
- Temporary dewatering and non-storm water discharge control system submittals
- Must comply with San Francisco Bay Regional Water
 Quality Control Board NPDES General Permit for Discharge
 or Reuse of Extracted and Treated Groundwater Resulting
 from the Cleanup of Groundwater Polluted by Volatile
 Organic Compounds, Fuel Leaks and Other Related
 Wastes (Order No. R2-2012-0012, NPDES No. CAG912002)



Project Overview: Earthwork

- Review Special Provisions Section 19 for Earthwork Requirements and all Informational Handouts.
- Soil Management Plan required for all soil handling
- Requirements for soil testing, disposal, and import vary by property (e.g. UPRR, Port of Oakland, Oakland Army Base, City of Oakland)
- UPRR requires Hazardous Material Management Plan for potential encountering of hazardous materials (will be added by Addendum)
- Information Handout includes Construction Risk Management
 Plan and C&M Agreement



Bonds and Insurance

Bonds

- Bid Bond 10% of Bid
- Payment Bond 100% of contract price
- Performance Bond 100% of contract price

<u>Insurance</u>

 Attention is directed to Section 7-1.06 "Insurance" of the Special Provisions for insurance requirements

Prevailing Wage/DIR Registration

- Prevailing Wage Rates required pursuant to the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations are available from the California Department of Industrial Relations' Internet web site at: https://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/DPreWageDetermination.htm
- Pursuant to Labor Code Sections 1725.5 and 1771.1, all contractors and subcontractors that wish to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, or enter into a contract to perform public work must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations

Bidding

- An electronic bidding process has been adopted for this solicitation. Paper bids will not be accepted. Electronic bids shall be submitted through: www.bidexpress.com/solicitations/27099
- All bidders must register on <u>www.bidexpress.com</u> and create Digital ID through Bid Express to submit a bid
- It can take up to five (5) business days to process your Digital ID and it is highly recommended that a Digital ID be active 48 hours in advance of submitting an electronic bid. Costs associated with obtaining said Digital ID and submitting a bid using Bid Express shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder.
