State funds govern; therefore, there are no contract equity goals. However, Alameda CTC strongly encourages the use of local and small local subcontractors/suppliers on this contract. Due to State funding requirements, local contract equity goals cannot be utilized.</p>

After bid opening will go through award process. Award sometime between February and May with construction starting in early summer 2023.</p>
