UPDATE: Eastshore Highway Closed At the I-80 Gilman Interchange in Berkeley Through September

BERKELEY / ALAMEDA COUNTY –Eastshore Highway is closed for one block between Gilman Street and Harrison Street at the Interstate 80 Gilman Interchange in Berkeley.

The block-long section of Eastshore Highway is closed to accommodate construction on a roundabout that will enhance safety and ease of use of the I-80 Gilman interchange. The roadway is scheduled to reopen at the end of September.

Caltrans has opened Second Street north of Gilman to two-way traffic to accommodate motorists during this closure. During the closure, there is no pedestrian access on Eastshore Highway. Sidewalks will remain open on Second Street.

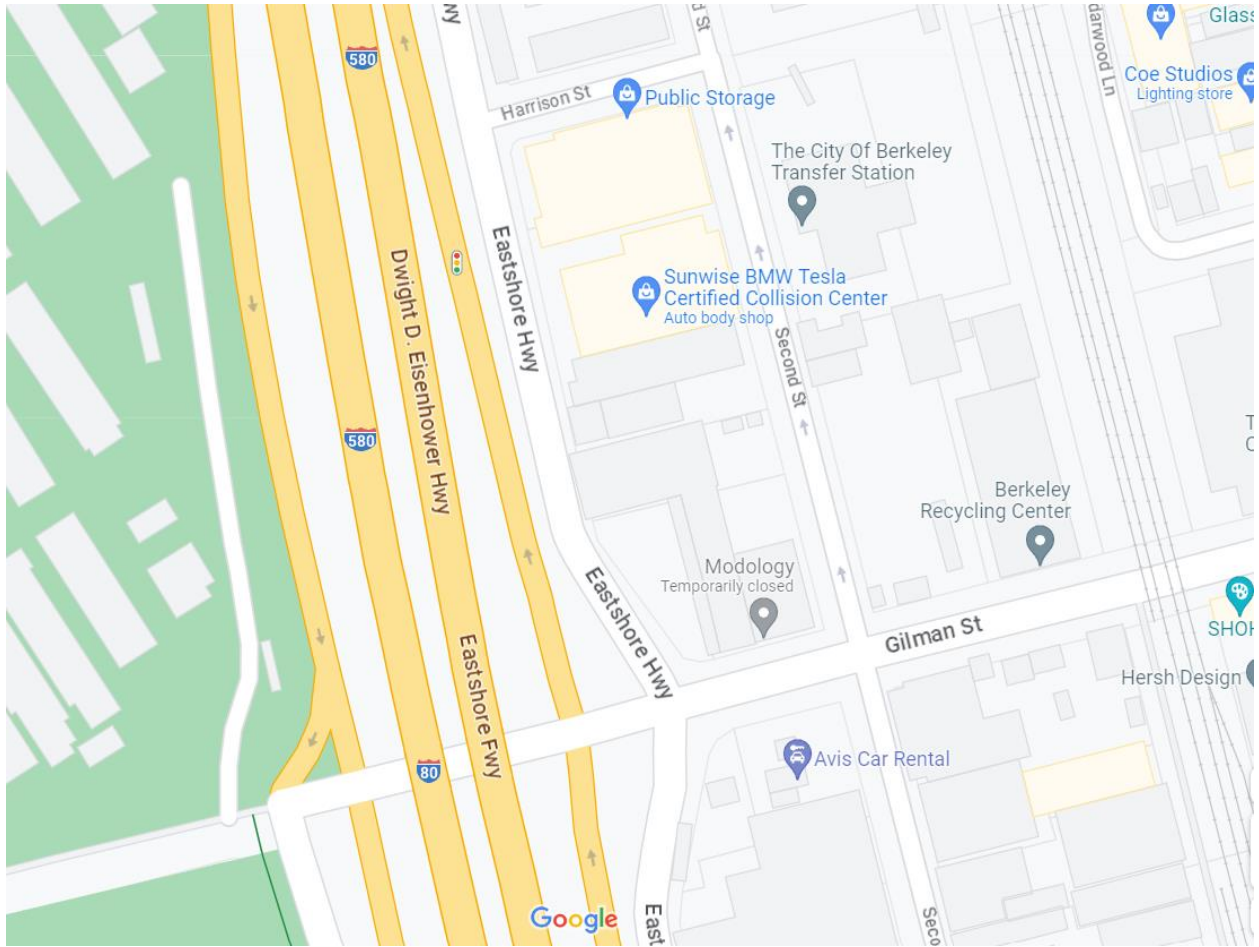
Signage will be present to guide motorists. When Eastshore Highway reopens in September, pedestrian and vehicle access will be restored on that street. Second Street will be returned to one-way northbound traffic north of Gilman Street.

Caltrans is aware of the inconvenience and impacts the closures present to the traveling public and thanks the public for your patience as we work to improve the I-80 Gilman interchange.

The project will improve traffic operations along Gilman Street between West Frontage Road and 5th Street through the I-80 Interchange, eliminating turn conflicts and enhancing safety for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists.

The main project components are two roundabouts at Gilman Street intersections on both sides of I-80, as well as a new bicycle/pedestrian overcrossing over I-80 and bicycle facilities at and near the interchange. The project will also close the gap in the Bay Trail at the west end of Gilman Street and create a dedicated two-way cycle track along Gilman Street from the interchange to Fourth Street.
