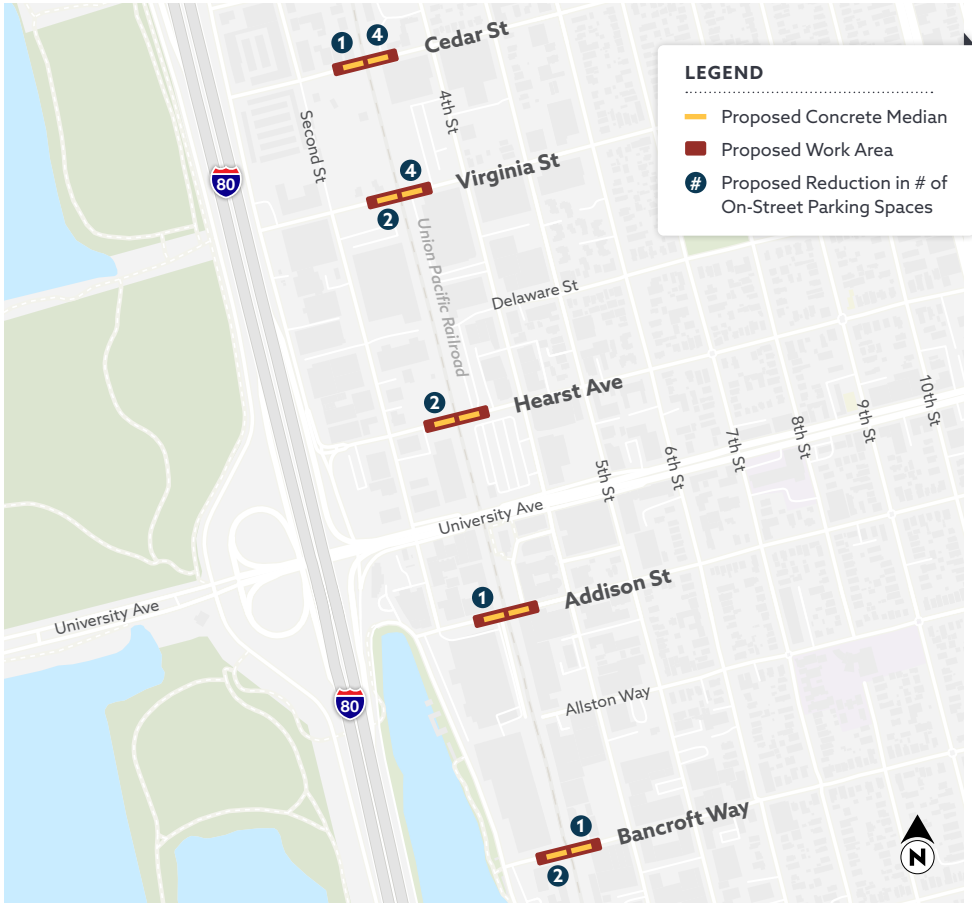




Join us for a Virtual Info Session on

The Alameda County Transportation Commission (ACTC) is improving rail crossing safety on **Cedar Street, Virginia Street, Hearst Avenue, Addison Street, and Bancroft Way** between Second and Fourth Streets. The proposed improvements will enhance the safety for vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians using the crossings.

This public information meeting is intended to discuss the improvements with nearby residents and businesses. Impacts may include **restricting left turn movements to adjacent driveways** and **reduction of on-street parking** adjacent to the railroad crossings.
