

## LEVINE ACT STATEMENT

### PRIME CONSULTANT/CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONSULTANT(S)/SUBCONTRACTOR(S) MUST COMPLETE, SIGN AND SUBMIT THIS STATEMENT

California Government Code § 84308, commonly referred to as the “Levine Act,” precludes an officer of a local government agency from participating in the award of a contract (including award of a contract amendment) if the officer receives any political contributions totaling more than \$500 in the 12 months preceding the date of the contract award from the person or company awarded the contract (or their agent), and prohibits such contributions while the matter is pending and for 12 months following the final decision. This prohibition applies to contributions to the officer, or received by the officer on behalf of any other officer, or on behalf of any candidate for office or on behalf of any committee. This prohibition does not, however, apply to contracts or amendments (i) awarded solely on the basis of lowest bid, (ii) valued under \$50,000, or (iii) where no party receives financial compensation.

Proposers/bidders are responsible for accessing this link to review the names prior to answering the following question:

**Have you or your company, or any agent on behalf of you or your company, made any political contributions of more than \$500 to any Alameda CTC Commissioner or Alternate in the 12 months preceding the date of the Alameda CTC Commission’s and/or any Committee’s consideration of the proposed contract?**

Answering yes to the question above does not preclude Alameda CTC from awarding a contract to you or your firm. It does, however, preclude the identified Commissioner or Alternate from participating in the contract award process for this contract, unless the Levine Act does not apply to the specific contract or amendment as detailed above.

Please note that any such contribution made (i) during the period between issuance of this procurement (i.e., RFP or RFQ) and the Commission’s final action on this contract, or (ii) during the 12-month period following the award of the contract is expressly prohibited under the Levine Act.

By signing below, the undersigned company affirms that the answer to the question above is true to the best of their knowledge, and acknowledges the prohibition on contributions in the Levine Act ([Government Code § 84308](#)) summarized above.
