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## What is GoPort?

[Global Opportunities at the Port of Oakland \(GoPort\)](#) is a series of transportation improvements at the Port of Oakland. One of several GoPort efforts, the 7th Street Grade Separation East (7SGSE) Project will replace the existing substandard railroad underpass on 7th Street between Interstate 880 and Maritime Street. Work is anticipated to begin this summer.

Initial construction efforts will focus on new roadway excavation and retaining wall construction north of the existing 7th Street where the new roadway will be. ADA-compliant curb ramps at 7th Street and Maritime Street will also be constructed. During this phase, 7th Street will remain open, providing two public lanes in each direction. Ghilotti Construction Company, which has a local office in Alameda County, will lead construction efforts.

Watch for updates about a community briefing and GoPort listening session to be scheduled soon.

## Project Benefits

- Improved truck and car access to the Port, relieving congestion
- Better safety and air quality
- Enhanced reliability of goods movement, augmenting the Port's global market position and creating more local employment opportunities
- Higher quality options for active transportation including upgrading the current bike and pedestrian pathway to today's ADA requirements and connecting with the Bay Trail and Middle Harbor Shoreline Park, and
- A landscaped underpass that incorporates community desired green features.
