



How can Alameda County residents save on transit?



Student Transit Pass

Eligible 6th–12th graders at over 160 Alameda County schools can apply for a free Student Transit Pass. The pass, which is loaded on a Youth Clipper card, provides free rides on local buses and other transit discounts. Eligibility is based on your school district. Learn more: bit.ly/studenttransitpass.

Not eligible? Youth ages 5-18 can still apply for a Youth Clipper card (see below).



Other Discount Clipper Card Programs

Below is a quick guide to reduced fares and discount passes for youth, older adults, riders with disabilities, and income-qualified riders. Learn more at: clippercard.com/discounts.

Who's it for?	What is it?	Discount	How to Apply?
Youth age 5-18 (4 and under ride free)	Youth Clipper	50% off BART + discounts on other Bay Area transit	Apply online, by email, by mail, or in person. Proof of age is required. (Student Transit Pass applicants receive a Youth Clipper card with their pass.) → clippercard.com/discounts
Adults age 19-64 with qualifying low income	Clipper START	50% off all Bay Area transit	Apply in person at the AC Transit office, Wheels office, Lake Merritt BART Station, or other designated locations. → clipperstartcard.com
People with qualifying disabilities under 65	Clipper Access (formerly RTC)	62.5% off BART + discounts on other Bay Area transit	Apply in person at the AC Transit office, Wheels office, Lake Merritt BART Station, or other designated locations. → 511.org/transit/clipper-access
Older adults (age 65 and over)	Senior Clipper	62.5% off BART + discounts on other Bay Area transit	Apply online, by email, by mail, or in person. Proof of age is required. → clippercard.com/discounts

Other Transit Discounts

Individual transit agencies such as **AC Transit**, **Wheels**, and **Union City Transit** may offer discounts for riders, including those who are involved in other transit programs.
