Prevailing Wage Requirements

Both the prime contractor and all subcontractor firm(s) required to hold a contractor's license for the performance of prevailing wage work must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) prior to the submittal of any bid.

Proof of such required registration for both the prime contractor and the specific team member holding the contractor's license must be submitted with the bid.

Prevailing Wage Requirements (cont.)

Contractors and subcontractors shall also comply with all applicable prevailing wage requirements and California Labor Code provisions, including payroll reporting and apprenticeship obligations.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Participation Program [49 CFR, Part 26]

- Per 10/3/2025 USDOT Interim Final Rule and Caltrans Office Bulletin #25-07, DBE participation counting and reporting are currently suspended; however, proposers must remain prepared for the potential reinstatement of goals.
- Only applicable to contracts funded via federal funds.
- Proposers remain responsible for verifying a firm's DBE eligibility via the California Unified Certification Program (CUCP) database at the time of proposal submittal, if applicable.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Participation Program [49 CFR, Part 26]

- Firms must possess the most specific North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes applicable to the specific work they are performing to ensure compliance with federal and state standards.
- The prime contractor is responsible for monitoring all subsequent federal and state policy updates to ensure immediate adherence to any future reporting or participation requirements.
