Continuing Compliance Certification And Statement of Financial Disclosure

IWC Membership Requirements:

Alameda County Transportation Commission's Independent Watchdog Committee (IWC) was established pursuant to the 2000 Measure B and 2014 Measure BB Transportation Expenditure Plans (Plans). Members of the IWC are appointed by either the Board of Supervisors, the Alameda County Mayors' Conference, or one of the appointing organizations specified in the Plans.

Pursuant to the requirements of the Plans, IWC members must be Alameda County residents, may not be elected officials at any level of government or public employees of an agency that oversees or benefits from the proceeds of the sales tax, and may not have any economic interest in any Measure B or Measure BB-funded projects or programs.

The purpose of this form is to confirm that each IWC member continues to be eligible to serve on the IWC, and this form also serves as the annual statement of financial disclosure referenced in the 2014 Plan. IWC members should keep in mind their obligation to recuse themselves from any matter that comes before the IWC in which they find that they do have a financial interest.
